A lifetime ago I was a house builder in Alaska, which taught me that making things matters. And people who make things matter.



For just over a year HatchSpace ran classes and built a strong community around the joy and dignity of fine woodworking.


Covid shut us down.


A come back.

Inspire a movement across America.






Hatch is here.






Project Budget and Gift Opportunities

The total cost of our effort to build, anchor, and scale the HatchSpace model is \$4M over the next three years. This includes \$1.6M to purchase our facility, \$1M for endowment, \$500,000 to sustain operating costs of our building for five years, and \$900,000 to partially subsidize our annual operations over the next three years.

Charitable giving makes up a significant source of HatchSpace income - both in annual operating expense and for this three-year project to scale our impact.

Building Our Foundation

Short-term funding needs

With your support and multi-year commitment, in 2023 HatchSpace will make \$119,000 in key investments in our facility, personnel and programs.

Facility

Our 7,000 SF space is already a jaw-dropping resource. To complete our plans we seek:

- High powered laser cutter for our CNC shop to expand our entry-level offering \$12,000
- Ventilated room upgrades, enabling users to create premium finishes to work \$9,000
- Expanded equipment including a lathe, bench-top tools, and air filters \$12,000

- Outreach Lead provides communication and program development support to engage external partners to generate service projects. \$15,000 .25 FTE



Programs

Learning programs and vibrant community experiences make HatchSpace irresistible. We will:

- Expand youth access to introductory programs and "camps" on a sliding scale to families and to our partners. \$20,000
- Establish an artist residency initiative that supports emerging woodworkers while replenishing and inspiring our community. \$18,000
- General support funding to carry out joint outreach and program design efforts with new partners. \$18,000
